I am 38 years of age, and was born in Carmont Pa State of Penna, now residing at Chartiersboro State of Penna, am by occupation an Engineer

I served in the late rebellion as follows:

First enlisted Oct 24th 18 61, as Private Co. A, 78th Regiment O.V.I. for the period of 3 years, and was discharged therefrom as Private, at Vicksburg Miss on the January 1st day of 1864, by reason of reenlistment

1 I also re-enlisted January 1st 18 64, as Private in Co. A 78th Regiment O.V.I. and was discharged therefrom as Private Louisville Ky on the eleventh day of July, 18 65, by reason of telegram from War Department

He was also in the first 3 month service. I have never borne arms against the United States, and have never been convicted by Court-Martial of Desertion, nor of any other infamous crime.

I have never made previous application for membership to the Grand Army of the Republic, and filed the same with my Post, No. Department of, on the day of
